

CONDITIONS

The right to a scholarship will only have the students who enrol for the first time in the school year for which the scholarship is awarded, who are citizens of Montenegro, and priority will be given to students residing in the Municipality of Mojkovac and municipalities in northern Montenegro.

Only students who are citizens of Montenegro, enrolled in one of the following fields of universities in the region, have the right to apply for a scholarship:

- Mining (Faculty of Mining and Geology, University of Belgrade)
- Geology (Faculty of Mining and Geology, University of Belgrade)
- Mining (University of Tuzla)
- Geology (University of Tuzla)
- Mining (University of Banja Luka)

Scholarships will be awarded to two students based on criteria (one from Mining Department, and one from Geology).

As well as students, citizens of Montenegro, enrolled at the Environmental Protection or Metallurgy (Faculty of Metallurgy and Technology, University of Montenegro).

The scholarship will be awarded to two students based on criteria (one from each department).

To be eligible for the Tara Resources Scholarship Program, applicants must fulfil the following criteria:

1. Have a minimum of 3.5 grade point average in the previous school year (for first year students), or 8.5 if applying after the first year of studies.
2. Be fluent in reading, writing, and speaking English. Second language is not mandatory but will be a plus.
3. Be able to travel abroad and take part in internship programs within the studies.
4. Be able to begin to work in Brskovo Mine or on some other project at Tara Resources upon completion of studies.
5. Be able to do an internship for at least 2 months a year during studies, in one of the mines in the region;

Supporting documentation to be submitted:

- Fully completed Application Form, with Personal Statement;
- CV;
- Recommendation Letter (at least one from professor/employer);
- Copy of ID;
- Certificate of residence;
- Certificate of enrolment at the stated year of studies;
- Copies of official school transcripts - grades (for first year students certified copies of grade transcripts from the final two years of high school and graduation grades);
- Statement certified by a registrar/notary regarding criterion 3, 4, and 5;
- One recent photo attached to the Application Form.

The selection of candidates will be performed by the Selection Committee Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview, during which there will be evaluation of English Language proficiency.

Candidates with a better grade average and a higher year of studies will have priority.

Submit application no later than: 15/10/2022

Number of scholarships: 4

Value and duration of scholarship: The value of the scholarship 1500 EUR per student per academic year.

Scholarships will be awarded upon the completion of the Competition, and will be paid in ten monthly instalments.
